



NAIT SYSTEM RELEASE 35

RELEASE NOTES

This release provides PICAs the ability to formally declare an 'unsafe to tag' animal exemption and make updates to their NAIT account as required.

DETAILS OF NEW /ENHANCED FEATURES

- PICAs can declare animals 'unsafe to tag' when moving to slaughter - using their NAIT account. The 'unsafe to tag' exemption replaced the '*impracticable to tag*' exemption in December 2019. To meet the conditions of the unsafe to tag exemption, a declaration must be made in NAIT before the animal is sent.
- PICAs can now make updates to the animals they have received if they die on farm, go missing, or lose a tag. Farmers that are sending animals off farm are required to record a sending movement in NAIT, but any inaction shouldn't prevent the receiver from fulfilling their own NAIT requirements.
- You can no longer record a movement to and from the same NAIT number. There is no requirement to record animals moving within the same NAIT location.
