



NAIT SYSTEM RELEASE 32

RELEASE NOTES

This release includes changes to NAIT movements to exclude animals that have been declared as 'dead', and changes to the NAIT CSI Animal Enquiry response.

DETAILS OF NEW/ ENHANCED FEATURES

- Animals that have been declared as 'dead' in the NAIT system will be excluded from any movements recorded after their date of death. A person recording a movement for a 'dead' animal will receive an error message notifying them that the animal will not be recorded in the movement. If an animal has been declared as 'dead' in error, it must be updated as 'alive' before it can be recorded in a movement.
- The NAIT CSI has been updated to return error messages when a dead animal has been recorded in a movement after the date of death. This enables third party software providers to display the correct error message to users submitting movement declarations to NAIT.
- The NAIT CSI has been updated to return the current NAIT number using the Animal Enquiry function. This enables information providers, meat processors and saleyards to query the current NAIT number of an animal via the CSI.
